Description:	Creating an invitation for your friends

Suggested procedure:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Revise the information about the Kardomah Gang with the children, using the Powerpoint presentation if desired.• Show the class some example invitations.• Discuss what information is required for a good invitation.• Ask them to think about creating an invite for famous people to come to the café.• Create a class list of the information that they will require on their invite. Possible things for them to think about would be ... Who is doing the inviting? Who is invited? Will they meet for a drink or will they have a meal? Where is the event taking place? (could be a real or fictitious place) When is the event happening? Where/To whom should people send a reply? What clothes should people wear? Will they include pictures? How will they organise their invitation?
Extension activities:	They could design the invitation using a computer program.
