| Year groups: | KS2 |

| Suggested procedure: | Review who Dylan Thomas was and his connection with Wales. Show the class some images of the Writing Shed, explaining that there is where he wrote. Discuss with the children what they would like to know about the Writing Shed. Distribute the Question Tree sheet and get the learners to fill it in. |
| Extension activities: | When they have completed the task, they could do some research on the Writing Shed using the document KS2_ReadingActivity_The Writing Shed' and internet links. |
