



Activity title:	Hotseating
Description:	Learners take it in turn to play the part of Dylan Thomas in the hotseat whilst the other learners ask questions in Welsh
Year groups:	Upper KS2

Suggested teaching sequence:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Explain that Dylan Thomas loved reading and writing but he was not keen on sport, although he did win a prize for running once. You can refer to the poster in the Wider Communication section of the website: (http://www.rockandrollpoet.co.uk/docs/ca2/adnoddau/KS2_WiderCommunication3_CYM_FINAL[1].pdf)• Show the learners the Hwb website showing sporting activities by going to the tab 'Gweithgaredd 2': (http://resources.hwb.wales.gov.uk/VTC/ngfl/wsl/bdag/chwaraeonahamdden-de/apps/simple-projector/index.html)• Get the learners to say the names of the activities.• Drill the learners with the question and answer forma "Wyt ti'n hoffi ...? "Ydw. Dw i'n hoffi ..." or "Nac ydw. Dydw i ddim yn hoffi..." using the sports mentioned.• Get the learners to work in pairs asking themselves which sports they like.• As a class then choose one learner to be Dylan Thomas. The other learners ask him questions about what he likes and doesn't like. The learner has to respond as they think Dylan Thomas would have responded.
Extension activities:	<p>The vocabulary can be extended by using the following forms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Rwy'n casáu - I hate• Rwy'n dwlu ar - I love• Mae'n well gen i - I prefer <p>The activity can be further extended by getting the learners to explain why they like a particular activity, e.g.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Rwy'n hoffi chwarae pêl-droed achos mae'n hwyl.
