

Independent thinking at KS4: Philosophy for children

**These lessons should follow the 'Self Destruct' lessons and learners should have some background knowledge of Dylan Thomas and his life before commencing this task.

- 1. Introduce the nature of P4C and ask learners to consider the objectives and rules carefully.
- 2. Follow the PowerPoint presentation looking at deceit and lies.
- 3. The purpose of P4C is to allow learners to express their views as and when they want do not force them to contribute or share views, simply encourage natural discussion.
- 4. After the lesson concerning deceit and lies (this will warm them up to the idea of a role model) ask learners to revisit biographical detail about DT and to consider and discuss whether he is a positive role model (ensure they don't simply focus on the tumultuous side of his character but also on his achievements)
- 5. This could be developed and other writers could be discussed too.
