# Unit 3: The causes of ill health in farm animals Teacher's notes

### Introduction

This theory session will take the learner through the **causes of ill health** in farm animals, classifying them into groups. They are:

- harmful organisms pathogens
- the animal's environment
- physical damage
- nutritional factors
- metabolic disorders
- stress
- chemicals
- allergies
- inherited problems

It will move on to introduce the concept of **pre-disposing factors** and the role of the stockperson in minimising these factors.

The session could begin with images of sick animals to stimulate discussion in the group as to the main causes of ill health.
